

## Peddlers and House-to-House Sales Application

(Ordinance No. 2017-10, 4.16)

Peddler or solicitor means any individual person, firm, company, partnership, corporation, society, religious sect, organization, or league, including, but not limited to, a trustee, receiver, agent, or similar representative of the same who engages in peddling or soliciting, whether or not payment is collected at the time of such transaction.

Peddling or soliciting means engaging in conduct whereby a person, organization, society, corporation, or its agent, member or representative seeks property, financial aid, gifts, money, or any article representing money or any article representing monetary value; or sells or offers to sell merchandise, goods, any article of value, service, publication, ticket, advertisement or subscription.

Applicant must file a bond with sureties approved by the City Clerk-Treasurer in the sum of \$1,000.00.

If all requirements are met, and the application is approved, the license will be issued within 48 hours. If the application is received on a Friday, the license will not be issued until the following Monday.
